COMMUNITY WORK

His community profile includes being past Chairman of Welfare for Chung Wah Association, Chairman for Special Networking for the WA Chinese Chamber of Commerce, corporate sponsorship of Activ Foundation's City to Surf fun run and Activ Foundation's Corporate Stairclimb Challenge at Central Park.

He is currently Chairperson of the Young Turks Group, a non-profit, social and business network group for CEO s, Directors and Emerging Professionals below the age of 40, which he founded some 6 years previously. He is also a current Board member at the Master Builders Association where he assists with health based issues in their health alliance.

In May 2008, Ian hosted a special fund raising event for Daniel Stokes, a 24 year old farmer who was made a quadriplegic due to a motor vehicle accident. His community event for Daniel echoes a need from his past where he was once also partially paralysed as a result of a grenade accident during his stint in the Singapore Armed Forces. Together with his team of health professionals, they managed to organise a Run-Walk-Cycle event for 200 individuals raising some \$3200 for the Daniel Stokes cause.

CYCLING

Ian's passion for cycling stems from his child years spent exploring the streets in Singapore. In 2006, he fulfilled a professional passion of using cycling as a medium of physical activity to promote health and wellness within his clinics and patients. The resultant PIHC Cycling Club has not extended its reach to include members of the public interested in taking up the sport for recreation and fitness with the focus on health and wellness. With some 200+ members in his club, Ian has a cohort of 4 cycling coaches with programs running every 10 weeks throughout the year. Ian is involved with the participation of cycling events such as Cyclosporitif, The Great Bike Ride, Freeway Bike Ride to name a few as well as community events which he either sponsors or assists with in kind. He is also a qualified cycling coach and has in 2008 been appointed on the Board for Cycling WA and is currently Chairperson for their membership benefits program.
